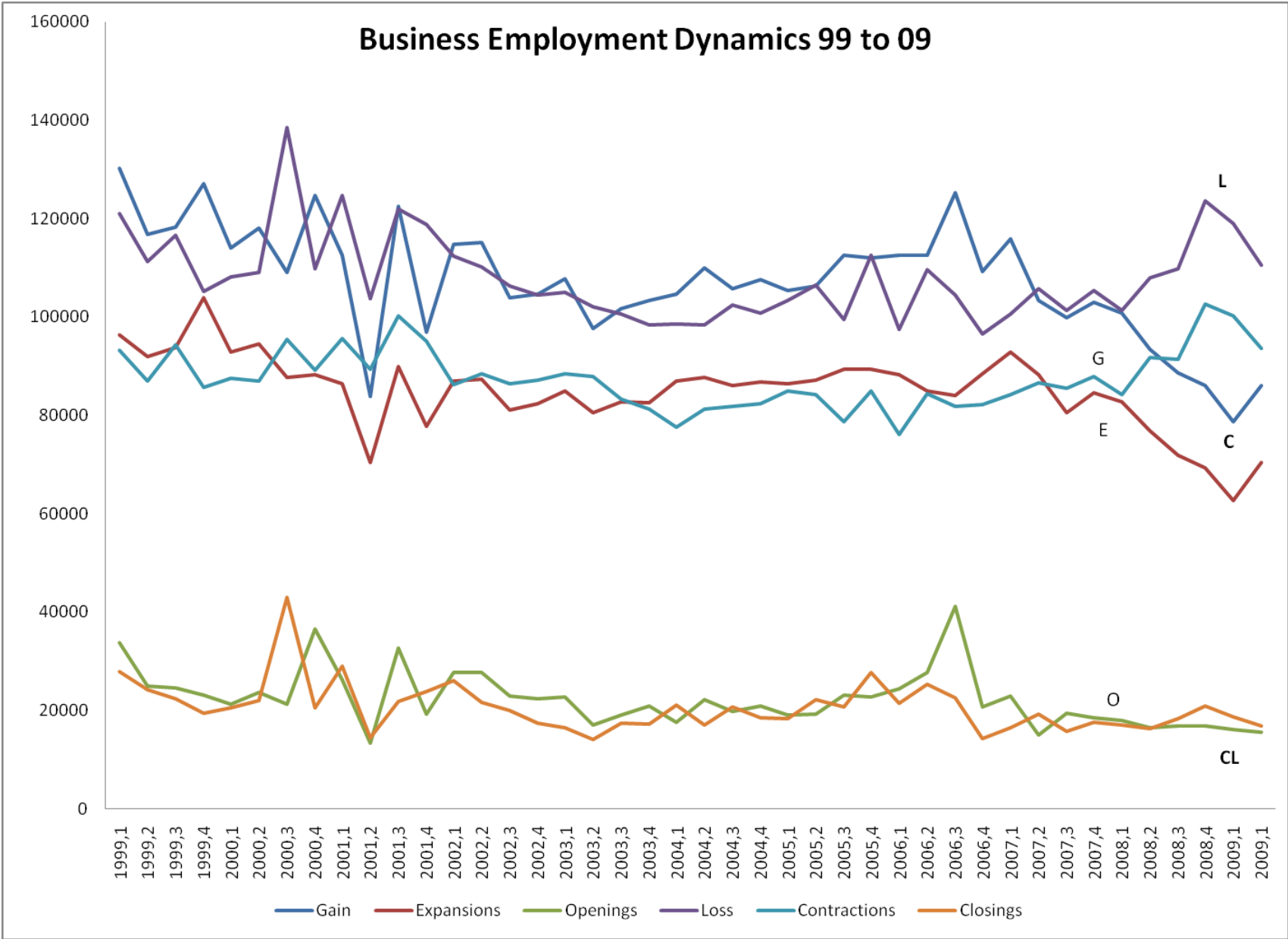

Business Employment Dynamics: Changes in Employment

- **Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages (QCEW)**
- ***Gains- Either opening establishments or expanding establishments.***
- *Expansions-* Current establishments with a net increase in employment.
- *Openings-* New establishments with positive employment.
- ***Loses - Either closing establishments or contracting establishments.***
- *Contractions-* Establishments with a net decrease in employment.
- *Closings-* Establishments with positive employment in the previous quarter, with no employment reported in the current quarter.
